**COMMUNION SUNDAY:** We will be celebrating the Lord's Supper this Sunday during our worship service.

 If you are worshipping with us in person, here's what to expect: When you check in on Sunday morning, you will receive small pre-packaged communion kit. Take it with you to your seat. At the correct time in the



service, remove the clear plastic top, revealing the wafer. Later, you will remove the second top and drink the juice. After the service, make sure to dispose of the remains in the garbage cans at the exit.

• If you are worshipping with us online, please gather bread, crackers, or rolls and something to drink (juice, wine, milk, water) ahead of time for all in your home who will be participating.

If you plan to attend in-person on Sundays, PLEASE NOTE:

- If you have had a fever, cough, above normal temperature, runny nose, sore throat, shortness of breath, reduction of sense of smell, or have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days, we ask that you stay home and watch the service online.
- Masks will be required.
- Seating will be limited to ensure social distancing.
- For your safety, prior to service, you will check in at the front doors, and be seated by ushers at a safe social distance.
- Hand sanitizer will be available in several easy-to-access spots.
- Our elevator will NOT be accessible.
- The Sanctuary will have **one entrance** and **one exit** only. Signs will point you in the right direction.
- We ask that you do not congregate in the Sanctuary at all after the service. If you wish to stop and visit with friends, please make your way out of the Sanctuary first and visit outside.
