# Praise Band Preview - Palm Sunday



The Session retreat catapults us into the busy and spiritually rich time of Holy Week. I hope you will prepare yourself for the various events of next week and participate to all you can:

- This Sunday, April 10, is Palm Sunday
- Wednesday, April 13, will be the last Lenten Lunch

- Then: Sing and say Alleluia! on Sunday morning, April 17, outside at 7:30 AM, or inside at 10:00 AM. God brings life from death, hope from emptiness, joy from despair.

If that were not enough to plan for, the next Saturday and Sunday (April 23 and 24), many of us will gather at Cedarkirk to celebrate the gift of God's creation and the fellowship of the church. *The Beloved Community in a Beloved Place* will be our theme: learning about Tikkun Olam - Repair the World. Taizé-style service with Scripture and Hymns; based on the worship style of an ecumenical Christian community in Burgundy, France, Taizé is a contemplative service centered around repetitive music, prayer, and silence, to quiet the mind, open the heart, and feed the soul. It is a simple, meditative form of worship, calling us to dwell deeply on Christ's presence around and within us.

#### **Easter Lilies**



In a world of disaster, hunger, and oppression, millions of people lack access to sustainable food sources, clean water, sanitation, education, and opportunity.

Typically received during the season of Lent, each gift to <u>One Great Hour of</u> <u>Sharing</u> supports efforts to relieve hunger (through the *Presbyterian Hunger Program*), promote development (through the *Presbyterian Committee on the Self-Development of People*), and assist in areas of disaster (through *Presbyterian Disaster Assistance*). The three programs all work in different ways to serve individuals and communities in need. From initial disaster response to ongoing community development, their work fits together to provide people with safety, sustenance, and hope.

#### Meal on Wheels - Volunteers Needed!


Meals on Wheels is a mission FPC has supported for over 50 years. Volunteers pick up and deliver meals to needy individuals from the Sunshine Center in downtown St. Pete. We currently make about 12 stops, and the whole process from pick-up to return takes about two hours. We deliver five days a week and ask that people sign up for the same day every week or every other week.

We are currently in need of someone on the 1st, 3rd, and 5th Monday of the month, the 3rd and 4th Wednesday, and/or occasionally as a back-up driver. Volunteers will take a short training course and fill out paperwork before being able to deliver. Please call Kathy Bardin at (727) 418-4577 if you are interested or have any questions. We encourage people to ride along with a current volunteer before making a decision.

number and your social security number. You do NOT need to be fingerprinted but the school will do a background check on you since we sit alone with each child.


