From the Desk of Pastor Ginny

My Dear First Prez Friends,

We are now just TWO WEEKS AWAY from beginning the important conversation: *THE ROAD AHEAD*. We will begin *The Road Ahead* on Sunday, September 11.

Are you ready? Have you begun packing? This journey is so important for the church, the participation of each of us is vital. And YES: that means YOU! YOU, YOU, and YOU.

You see, each week, during the four weeks of *The Road Ahead*, we will look at a topic about *The Road Ahead* for First Presbyterian Church. Each week, small conversation groups will discuss that topic. We want you to join in one of the groups each of the four weeks. You can come in person, or you can meet with

a Zoom group. You can wear masks, or you can come "as you are." For the four weeks, you can choose to stay in the same group, or move around as you need to because of your schedule. You have lots of freedom in this, because duh, we are Presbyterians! Freedom, but responsibility too: to join is to sign up!

Here's a preview: the first topic is "The Good Old Days." What do YOU remember about the Good Old Days? ... whatever days those were for you ... wherever you were. We'll talk about that on Sunday, September 11. Then we will explore that topic in the small groups meeting that next week, in person, or on ZOOM. I am asking you to sign up for one of the conversation groups (keep reading for how to do that!).

WHEN ARE THE GROUPS?

Below is the initial schedule. I hope there will be enough opportunity for each and all of you. If not, I can add groups. If too few sign up for a group, we may need to close out that time. We'll see how it goes and we will keep you posted.

GROUP DAYS AND TIMES, which will meet each of the four weeks, beginning Sunday Sept 11:

- 1. SUNDAYS at 11:15 a.m. in the Chapel (2nd group in Youth Center if needed)
- 2. SUNDAYS at 11:30 a.m. ON ZOOM (join in from wherever you are!)
- 3. MONDAYS at 2:00 p.m. in the Chapel
- 4. TUESDAYS at 4:30 p.m. on ZOOM
- 5. WEDNESDAYS at 10:00 a.m. in the Youth Center
- 6. WEDNESDAYS at 7:00 p.m. on ZOOM
- 7. THURSDAYS at 10:00 a.m. in the Chapel

If these times don't include a time you need, please let me or the Church Office know. Do we need more evening groups? Do we need a Saturday? I want to offer the times needed so everyone can participate. Your ideas and feedback are really important as we look at *The Road Ahead* for the church!

HOW DO YOU SIGN UP?

You can sign up for a group electronically by **CLICKING HERE**. Please note that you can choose options for all four weeks right now, or you can just sign up for one now, and other weeks later (using the same link), as you know your schedule. **Or** there will be a table in the back of the church every Sunday, starting this Sunday, with a paper sign-up sheet so you can select the group that works best for you.

CAN YOU GATHER YOUR FRIENDS FOR A GROUP?

Sure! Why not? We want everyone to join in, as they are best able.

I am getting really excited about looking with you at *The Road Ahead*. Please do all you can to participate as fully as you are able.
