From the Desk of Pastor Ginny

Dear Friends,

At its July meeting, the Session approved beginning the search for a new installed pastor. I want to let you know what this will involve, and I hope to answer some of your questions.

OVERVIEW:

Presbyterian searches for pastors are careful processes. Unfortunately, they always seem to take longer that we expect or wish. My guess is that this process for FPC will take between one and two years (!). That said, I want to reassure you that I am putting no time-line on my ministry here. My expectation is that things will remain stable and busy throughout the search.

STEPS IN THE PROCESS:

- 1. We have already informed the Presbytery about the Session's recent action. Presbytery is our partner in relationships with ministers.
- 2. Our Congregation's Nominating Committee will start this work. Jo Anne Malone is chair of the committee; she has already begun planning the work needed to nominate a Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC).
- 3. The PNC will be representative of the whole congregation and will be elected by the congregation at a duly called Congregational meeting, perhaps in September. We imagine that the PNC will be comprised of 7 members and 2 alternates. Their job will be strenuous: meeting two or more times monthly for a year, more likely even longer.
- 4. You will be invited to suggest names for consideration for the PNC, and you will be asked to pray for the Nominating Committee as it seeks the right members for the PNC. You will also be asked to pray for the PNC as they do their work.
- 5. Note that only church members can be elected to serve on the Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC).

HOW LONG WILL THE SEARCH TAKE? Between one and two years. Maybe more. Have patience! (Patience was last week's sermon topic; go back and listen again!)

HOW WILL THIS AFFECT OUR CURRENT STAFF? We do not expect anything to change here at FPC while the search is underway.

ARE WE READY? I believe that you are ready for this step. You have dealt with the conflict of recent years, facing the issues and the emotional turmoil. You have come to a good place of faith, with energy, compassion, and outreach, balanced by good worship and strong leadership from elders, deacons and staff.

IS THERE ANXIETY ABOUT THIS? Yes, my friends, I know some of you are anxious about this, about how to get the future "right." We need to remember that the church is, as always, in God's hands. We will go step by step into this process, as we go into all our work. We will trust God with the people, the interactions, the timing, and the decisions. The winds of the Spirit will blow, filling our sails. There may be times when the wind is light and progress seems slow; that may simply be God's way of preparing us all for the future, getting everything and everyone ready for the next part of the journey. (We're back to patience, one of the Fruits of the Spirit).

As always, I ask that you surround our church staff, the Session, the Nominating Committee, and ultimately the PNC with your faithful prayers. Give your support, your encouragement and your patience to this process. And then watch and wait with expectation for the good and wonderful things God is doing, and will do, in our very midst.

Kickoff Sunday We're Making Plans for the Kyiv Symphony Orchestra and Chorus Concert

Performing in our Sanctuary on September 17 at 4 p.m. will be the Kyiv Symphony Orchestra and Chorus (KSOC). Thirty women of that organization are on a "Hope for Ukraine" Concert Tour throughout

the southeastern United States. Their mission is to raise funds for humanitarian aid to women, orphans, war victims, and anyone in need of hope and physical comfort. These world-class musicians will present selections including sacred classical masterpieces, Ukrainian folk songs (performed in Ukrainian dress), and contemporary jazz works. This Sunday, August 6, at our Kickoff Sunday, we will share with you more detailed information about this exciting event and ask for your help. 
Seeking Church Van Drivers!
