From the Desk of Pastor Ginny

Dear Friends,

This Sunday begins Advent, with the theme of Waiting and Hoping. One of my Advent devotionals offers this prayer for the first of the four weeks of Advent: *Gracious God, I put myself before you in this moment with waiting heart, expectant desire. Open my eyes that I may see your promise fulfilled; open my ears that I may hear your word whispered to my deepest being. Amen.*

That prayer reminds me to place myself in God's very presence and to pray expectantly, not passively. It reminds me to pray hopefully, ready to see and hear God speaking to me. Thinking of my prayer in this way, I am stirred to think that if I listen really well, I really may hear God's word whispered into my deepest being, right there, within me.

What word might be whispered to you?

Might God whisper to you one of these things?

It will be okay.... I have a job for you to do... I love you, no matter what....

You will get through this.... I have heard your prayer and I will answer....

Well done, good and faithful servant....

I love to imagine us praying as a church: expectantly, hopefully. Listening for the words of God to fill us with peace, to guide us into service, to lead us to generosity for the world's great needs.

As we pray for our Pastor Nominating Committee, we join them in expecting God's love wrapping itself around this church as you move into the future, with leaders and ministries as yet still unknown to us, but known to God. As we pray for our staff, we lift them up in their work and in their faith, for God's blessing.

As we pray for our congregation, we pray for their health, their comfort, their encouragement.

I join you in praying today and in these weeks of Advent, with waiting heart and expectant desire.

FPC at the Santa Parade last Saturday (11/25)!





December's "Wednesday Night" Supper is on a <u>Tuesday</u> for HoHoHo TACO TUESDAY!


