### From the Desk of Pastor Ginny

Dear Friends,

Despite my best efforts – getting all the shots, keeping distances - I did get COVID, so I have spent this last week at home: coughing some, resting a lot, working a little, generally being quiet. I hope to get back to some sort of "normal" as soon as I can.

That said, I am making plans to offer a Sunday morning class from 10:15 to 10:45 each week. Let's call it Presbyterianism. I'll make the class pretty fluid, so it can cover the basics about our beliefs, structure, and character as well as things our people may have questions about. I want to add in two other things on a regular (monthly) basis: an Inquirer/Membership class most months and an introduction to one of the creeds or confessions we have in our Book of Confession. The class will meet in the Church Office Conference Room, upstairs just past the choir room. For the next month or so, we'll do this:

- Feb. 4 no class, due to Annual Congregational meeting
- Feb. 11 New Member Inquirers Class for those who would like to know more about the church and consider becoming members
- Feb. 18 What makes us Presbyterian?
- Feb. 25 A look at the Apostles and Nicene Creeds
- Mar. 3 How Presbyterian Churches function
- Mar. 10 New Member Inquirers Class for those who would like to know more about the church and consider becoming members

We do have three other vibrant Adult classes: **Faith Journey** meets in Room S-202 to discuss chosen readings on faith development and deeper spirituality; **Power Hour** meets in the Youth Center Café area with discussion on Biblical themes; and a **Next** group for young adults/parents using short, theologically informed videos, meeting downstairs in Room S-100.

First Presbyterian Church will hold its ANNUAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING ON FEBRUARY 4 at the close of each worship service.




The 2023 Annual Report from all of our church

effort and donate 160 pairs. All sizes are needed, from size 5 to 12, boys and girls.



#### We're asking for three things from our generous members:

- 1. Sneakers
- 2. Money for Socks
- 3. To help us box and pack the sneakers during our next Mission Sunday, February 18. We will do this between the two services, from 10-11 AM.

Let's first discuss the boxing and packing. We need as many hands as possible to help us box and pack during our next Mission Sunday, February 18. Time 10-11am, the hour between our two services. Our Fellowship Committee has graciously offered to provide light refreshments.

Where? Fellowship Hall.

(P.S. The Mission Committee has learned its lesson: At the previous Mission

Sunday we didn't wait for church members to show up while we did much of the work with little left for others to do. From now on, we'll help organize and assist but let you do the work. Scout's honor.)

Now let's talk socks. Rather than ask members to buy socks individually at a higher price, we're asking you to contribute \$money\$ so the committee can purchase the socks in bulk.



Finally, the sneakers. To make sure our generous members don't all contribute one size—say, size 5 boys—a board will be at each service with tabs on it that you can pull off. This tab will designate a shoe size and kind (boy or girl) for you to purchase. Select

whatever color you like. And take as many tabs as you like!

What to do with the sneakers? You can bring your sneakers to church prior to February 18. Bins labeled *Lakewood Sneakers* will be available beneath the Giving Tree at each service for you to place them in. If you would like to contribute money for the socks, please place your check in the offering plate, made out to First Presbyterian; Memo line: *Lakewood socks*. Or, you can deposit cash or check made to FPC in an envelope attached to the tab board.

- 1. a completed application form;
- 2. a copy of your most recent high school or college transcript;
- 3. a 500-word essay describing your involvement in church-related activities as well as extra-curricular and community involvement activities, why you want this grant, and what you expect to do following the completion of

your education.

The Scholarship Committee will review the applications and the Session will approve the final awards. Successful applicants will be asked to provide proof of enrollment and acceptance by their educational institution. Funds for the scholarship will be sent directly to the institution so be sure to give the proper name and address to which the funds are to be sent. Questions? 
