Take a listen to this week's Sonshine City Podcast <u>HERE</u> as Pastors Dawn and Megan introduce and chat about the






Sonshine City Podcast will appear weekly in First News to shine the light of Christ's love into your day.





# Devotionals Available in the Church Office


