If the 10 AM hour on Sundays does not fit your schedule, the service is available for viewing on our YouTube channel throughout the week. Feel free to share the link with family and friends!



### Church Membership: How to Become A Part of Our Church Family



The mission committee received a lovely note from the Mullins describing their life now that they have retired from active mission ministry. In part it read, "we are both enjoying our retirement, good health and continuing to be involved as much as possible in the work God has called us to do here in Brazil."

The note included a description of the work the donations from First Presbyterian Church have allowed them to do. They said "your gifts provide compassionate care for those who are ill and seeking medical care;...the funds also help with special needs for several Brazilian missionaries serving with New Tribes Mission, Mission Aviation Fellowship, and the Brazilian Association of Retreats and Christian campus."

The Mullins' also offered these kind words for our congregation: "we want to take this opportunity to share our gratitude for your continued financial contributions to our mission account at United World Mission."

This mission couple's work over the years has included "equipping leaders, establishing churches, engaging in holistic ministry by partnering with the church globally."

We are grateful for their ministry and wish them well in their retirement. In retirement, they remain in Brazil where they have worked for many years.


