

Dear First Pres Friends,

Up here in the Church Office, there was big potted plant, a schefflera, looking really sad, not at all healthy. We kept watering it and it kept drooping. Finally, we decided to re-pot it. It couldn't hurt, is what we figured. It turns out there was no hole in the bottom of the pot: the plant was swimming in water! We punched holes in the pot, we pruned away the unhealthy branches, and put the plant back in its pot with lots of good new soil. Then we brought it upstairs to the pastor's porch. Now I carefully water the plant twice a week and look at it! It is so alive! so happy! It is flourishing.





Years ago, I heard a story about a community center working with inner city kids. One week they told the kids to bring some dirt from home because they were going to plant seeds. One of the children didn't bring any dirt. They asked him. "Mike, why didn't you bring any dirt? We reminded you every day this week." "No," Mike said, "Why should I bring any dirt? No, that is not a typo! It is an intentional mashup, a purpose-filled sandwich of worship, fellowship, mission, and lunch (yes, there will be lunch!)


Where can YOU be a part of GOD's work? Downstairs, Sunday morning (Sunday, July 31st) where the Praise Band will lead us in worship!

From Dr. Cesar Davila New Hope Clinic, Honduras

Greetings and Blessings,

We are facing a new rebound of the Corona virus, The positive cases and deaths for this virus have increased after a "temporary decline" of cases. I believe that this phenomenon has been the experience in almost all countries. The primary care centers for COVID, the emergency



rooms, and intensive care units have experienced a proportional increase in cases. In the clinic, we have also seen a moderate increase in COVID cases, with the difference being that the patients do not need hospitalization, nor are they very ill as was the case at the beginning of the pandemic.

The government is planning to take new means to help contain the contagions which have shot up in an exponential manner. One of these means is to close events where a great number of people concentrate such as: concerts, soccer games, parades, and the majority of schools have returned to virtual learning.

We are also under the threat of Dengue; I believe that we always have Dengue cases in this country at the beginning of May, which is winter here in Honduras. There is an increase in rain, which favors the mosquito population. At the hospitals, they are registering a large number of cases of Dengue and some deaths from hemorrhagic Dengue. This winter has been very rainy, and last week we were confronted with the first tropical storm of the season. Thanks to the Lord there was only minor damage.

In the clinic, we are maintaining biosecurity measures, we have never lowered our guard, and we are stepping up our methods because of this new rebound of the virus. Thanks to the Lord and the Foundation, our patients continue to receive their timely treatments. They are very grateful to God and the Foundation for all the blessings we receive through you.
