#### Hi there!

I am back in Florida, enjoying the sun and sea, after equal delights of mountains and cool air from our vacation in Montreat. Being with much of my family was a joy: our three children, our five grandchildren, their families, as well as some 23 various other siblings, cousins, etc. It was a busy and fun time!

I wanted to let you know that the Presbyterian General Assembly was held earlier this summer. The meeting was held in a "hybrid format," with committees meeting in person in Louisville KY but in shifts (three Committees at a time), then all the plenaries (that is, whole group meetings) were held on Zoom. The GA wrapped up its work on Saturday July 9. We have ordered the post-GA reports for our church. There will be some copies to pick up at the Welcome Center this coming Sunday, or you can download and read it using THIS LINK. I think you will want to be aware of what our elected commissioners have said to the church and to the world at this momentous time. In fact, I plan to meet with the Faith Journey Class at 8:30 this Sunday morning (July 31) to talk about the GA actions and what they might mean for the church. You might like me to offer a fuller class time on these topics in the fall; let me know if you would be interested in this. One of our presbytery's GA commissioners was elder Kathy Sandy from Village Church in Tampa (who was on our Administrative Commission); Kathy said it is good to have some context for the actions that were taken and the statements the GA offered.

Meanwhile I will see you soon, certainly on Sunday (MissionSunday) July 31! Be ready to come to worship, to serve, and to join in a lunch fellowship!

Blessing of the Backpacks Sunday, August 14


As hard as it is to believe, the end of summer is right around the corner! As kids get ready to return to school, we would like to send
