


Ladies, you are invited to Lisa Harper's new Bible Study! Luke: Gut-Level Compassion

## Fun Facts About the Ukraine – Did You Know?

The world's longest wind instrument is the Ukrainian trembita. Listed in The Guinness Book of Records, the trembita is a wooden trumpet that ranges in length from 8 to 26 feet and has a diameter of roughly 1.2 inches. In mountain villages, the trembita was used as a means of communication sending important or urgent messages from mountain to mountain with the sound reaching as far as 6.2 miles. Today it is enjoying a revival after being embraced by contemporary musicians.
