Called Congregational Meeting June 6, 2021 at 1:00 PM

The congregational meeting at 1 PM has been called by the session for the purpose of asking the congregation to support Pastor Dawn's request to ask the Presbytery to dissolve her call as our senior pastor. The Rev. Dr. John DeBevoise has been appointed by the Presbytery to moderate the meeting, which will include both on-site and online opportunities for those on the active members' role to attend and participate.

Voting will be limited only to active members who attend the meeting on-site or online, just as it is in any meeting. The session has decided not to require a written ballot by mail-in or drop-off, which would have delayed learning the results of the vote for a week or more.


Online Participants

At the request of the presbytery-appointed moderator and consistent with Presbytery of Tampa Bay practice for online presbytery meetings, pre-registration is required to join the congregational meeting online, participate in the discussion, and vote.

Pre-registration is a simple, but multi-step process. Please don't wait until Sunday at 1 PM to pre-register; please do it today if at all possible!

Join our GriefShare group on Sundays at 4 PM (via Zoom)

Whether your bereavement experience is recent or not so recent, you will find encouragement, comfort and help in grieving the death of a spouse, child, parent, sibling, other family member, or friend.

This program features biblical, Christ-centered teaching that focuses on grief topics associated with the death of a loved one. The 13-week DVD seminar features nationally respected grief experts and real-life stories of people, followed by a small group discussion about what was viewed.
