From the Desk of Pastor Ginny

Dear Friends,

Pride Month is the month of June. As a church that is open, welcoming, and affirming of all, we will take the Sundays of June to look at and celebrate diversity. This focus could, of course, simply grow out of my own heart and mind as your preacher. But I believe it will be a more authentic and powerful message if some of you have experiences you are willing to share with me ---your own or your family's stories of challenge, of faith, and of hope. You could talk with me in person or on the phone (Yes, I do talk on the phone sometimes; is that old school, do you think?). Or you could write your story and send it to me. I realize this is like the sailing stories you provided earlier that we all found so meaningful. I imagine working some of those stories into sermons in June, anonymously, or with names as you are comfortable. We could perhaps create time and space for some of you to share your stories in person if you are willing.

We Presbyterians believe the scripture (John 3:16) that God so loved the world

that God gave Jesus, the Son, the Savior. God loves the world -- the whole world! No one is left out of God's love. We believe the scripture that *God created humankind, all of us, in God's very own image* (Genesis 1:27). In June we will think about how we live out that conviction and how we speak up in our world to affirm that this is really true.

I am looking to the month of June as a time for us to explore and celebrate this topic as a people of faith, a people who follow Jesus Christ. Oops, one more thing: I will be away June 25, so my chance to share any of your precious stories would be best earlier in the month.


Sunken Gardens Outing Thursday, June 1 10 AM - 12 PM
