Called Congregational Meeting June 6, 2021 at 1:00 p.m.


As was announced in last Friday's First News, the session has called a congregational meeting for 1:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 6, 2021, in response to a request from at least one-fourth of the active membership of the

congregation for the purpose of deciding whether to dissolve Pastor Dawn's relationship with the church.

As most of you know by now after reading Pastor Dawn's letter sent out to the congregation on Tuesday, after much prayer and discernment, Dawn decided to ask that the congregation vote next Sunday to ask the Presbytery to dissolve her call as your senior pastor. She discussed her decision with the session Monday night, and then Rev. Bobby Musengwa moderated a portion of the meeting while she stepped out of the room. In her absence, the session decided to support her request and will be presenting a motion with additional recommendations at the congregational meeting.

Because of how this congregational meeting came to be called at this time, the Rev. Dr. John DeBevoise has been appointed by the Presbytery to moderate the meeting. The meeting will include both on-site and online opportunities for those on the active members' role to attend and participate. Voting will be limited only to active members who attend the meeting on-site or online, just as it is in any meeting, but the session has now decided <u>not</u> to require a written ballot by mail-in or drop-off, which would have delayed learning the results of the vote for a week or more.

Details about how to attend, participate, and vote will be sent out in an email in the next few days and in First News next Friday.
