


Blue Christmas Comfort Service Thursday, Nov. 30, 5 PM

December's "Wednesday Night" Supper is on a <u>Tuesday</u> for HoHoHo TACO <u>TUESDAY!</u>



A Beautiful Expression of Gratitude

Soon after the Kyiv Symphony Orchestra and Chorus performed so gloriously in our sanctuary, our Carlen Maddux composed the following thought-filled poem reflecting on the entire 'Ukrainian' experience.

> September 17, 2023: The Day that Joy Flowed Through Hearts Scarred with Strife

One church. One choir. Two countries.

Bound together in this moment in time, in a city interestingly named...

St. Petersburg.

All hurt by loss, some tragic, some lesser.

All pained.

On this day, twenty-eight young women from Ukraine Walked into the womb of a sanctuary to sing their hearts out. A thousand and more heard. They listened, they experienced, they responded.

A church struggling to recover its way opened its heart and its doors.

These young women struggling with loss of home and loss of loved ones

Sang music and song forged from

The blood of their heartland.

Both church and choir united in one accord, as givers and receivers.

Both church and choir wept tears and erupted in laughter

Long lost and forgotten.

On this day, in this moment both church and choir Were woven as one, graced in love and hope.

And just days later, while these young women
Shared meals with their hosts and visited museums and beaches,
Their President and our President spoke with one voice to the United Nations:
"Stop this tragic loss! Stop this unwarranted war!"

And in St. Petersburg, at this church they call First Presbyterian, Its members as one experienced a deeper and fuller sense of God's Presence.

Is this what You call a holy moment? Is this Your resurrection moment? Is this just a mere "coincidence"?

However described, we are...
Captive to Your Love, our Father and Creator;
Grounded in Your Humility, our Brother and Christ;
Embraced by Your Joy, our Mother and Spirit.
Thank You. Thank You. Thank You.
