From the Desk of Pastor Ginny

Dear Friends,

We are turning a corner as you elect a Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC). It's a corner we have been moving toward for the entire two years I have been here as Interim Head of Staff: preparation for the next chapter in this church's ministry. We are talking about the church as a sailboat, and I am imagining the parts of the sailboat. Can you name some of those parts? Can you think of which of the parts of the boat you represent: hull, deck, sail, rudder, anchor, galley, others? Which are you? Where has God called you to serve, maybe just in this particular moment in your life? We might be talking about this a bit on Sunday afternoon's final Visioning Conversation (4 p.m., Fellowship Hall).

Meanwhile we are meeting after each worship service this week to elect the PNC. Here are the names of the nominees being presented by your Nominating Committee:

Bryan Bardin grew up in this church. He is a professional, is single and under 40. Bryan is very creative and is part of the tech team at our Connect service. He worked 7 years as Director of Children and Youth Ministry in a PC(USA) church in NY and is an ordained elder. He is a favorite uncle for four beautiful children.

<u>Don Doddridge</u> is a member of our Session, serves on the Finance Committee, and chairs the Property Committee. Don was CEO of One Blood, Inc. before he retired, and next year will chair the Board of Westminster Communities of Florida, which manages senior residential facilities, including three here in St. Petersburg. Don is active in our Men's Meal Ministry.

April Hussung coordinates the Tuesday morning Women's Bible Study here at FPC and works part-time at a law firm. An ordained elder, April has a heart for mission; she went many times to Honduras with our Mission Team. She and husband Brad have three grown daughters and three grandchildren. Usually at the Connect service, April is sometimes at the 11:00.

Lynne Mormino is on our Board of Deacons, a member of PW Circle 9 and on the Beach Drive Forum Task Force. Lynne sings in our choir, is active on our Mission Committee and is involved with a number of the non-profit agencies in St. Petersburg. She worked 38 years with Social Security Administration and has a lively interest in the music of American history.

<u>Chris Mossman</u> recently retired (early) from the media field where he traveled nationally and internationally in his work. A businessman with many organizational skills, Chris is personable and friendly. He attends the Connect service at 9:00 with wife Karen. Chris recently served on the Strategic Property Task Force and is a member of the Personnel and Administration Committee.

<u>Kirby Volz</u> recently moved to St. Petersburg from Indiana where he taught high school drama. Here in Pinellas County, Kirby stays active with community drama groups, sings in choruses and in our choir when he can; he is also a substitute teacher in the school system. An ordained elder, Kirby attends our 11:00 service and serves as a liturgist.
