A Note from Pastor Ginny

FROM THE CORNER OFFICE:

Thank you, my friends, for your encouragement and your welcome, both in September when I came as your Temporary Stated Supply and then in mid-October when I was chosen to stay on as your ongoing Transitional Pastor. That means we will be working together for approximately two years, as we resolve issues and restore community and collaboration here at First Presbyterian. I have already come to appreciate the quality of your excellent staff, the joy of your worship, and the eagerness you show to be about the work of Jesus Christ here in St. Petersburg. Please know that I want to hear what you have to say; I want to be your partner in both worship and in the work of discipleship. And, yes, you should call me Ginny!

OFFICE HOURS:

Megan McMillan and I have decided to keep regular office hours. We are well aware that there will be variations to this schedule, as we juggle meetings here and on Zoom and other necessary appointments, but you might find it helpful to know when we expect to be at the church:

- I, Pastor Ginny, will work from home on Mondays and will plan to be at the church on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays, from 10:00 AM to 3:30 PM, more or less. I will take Fridays off.
- Pastor Megan will be at the church on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays from 10:30 AM. She will work from home on Thursday. She will take Fridays off.
- Feel free to make appointments. Call or e-mail so that we can be available to you as needed.

UPDATE from the Officer Nominating Committee

A little "Presbyterian-ese": Elders and Deacons are "ordered ministries" in the Presbyterian church. They are elected by the congregations where they are members and where they will serve. They are then trained for their work, and ordained (set apart) at worship and installed to their office. Currently First Presbyterian has a number of vacancies on the Session (the group of elders) and on the Board of Deacons. In fact, the reason the church has an Administrative Commission from Presbytery is that our Session currently (with 5 elders) does not have a quorum to do business. Presbytery is helping and supporting us with the AC until we can elect, train, and install new elders and regain our quorum.

For this purpose, the Officer Nominating Committee is continuing its work, first to develop a slate of elders, then a second slate for deacons. When ready with either slate, the committee will request the Session and Administrative Commission to call a congregational meeting for the election. We have hopes that (at least) the meeting to elect elders will be scheduled soon. Please

continue to hold our work in your prayers.


