Praise Band Preview - Fellowship Hall This Week!




New Member Inquirer's Class Sunday, November 13 immediately following worship in the Youth Center

will be closed off for the morning (6-10:30 AM). Please make plans to park in our ample grass parking area south of the sanctuary, or in the front circle drive.


Our church will be assisting RunFest in the


St. Pete Baroque Concert Sunday, November 20, 2022 at 4:00 PM
