All participants will need to pre-register for this meeting, as we have done in the past. The Zoom pre-registration link with instructions will be published in First News the next two Fridays (Nov. 5 and 12).

Only active members of the congregation may speak and vote; affiliate members may speak but may not vote. Other participants in the life of the congregation may be recognized at the discretion of the moderator if necessary. If you have any questions about your membership status, please contact the Church Office.

After elders are elected, they will undergo training, they will be examined, and then ordained and/or installed. At that time, the Presbytery's Administrative Commission will be dismissed and the church Pastor will become the Moderator of the Session.

A later congregational meeting will be called for the election of Deacons.


FPC Concert Series VOCES8 Tomorrow, October 30, 2021
