And what fun we had Sunday afternoon! Forty or so came to engage about the future of the church, and they came with energy and great spirits. I put everyone to work, placing sticker-dots on boards to give us a "snapshot" of who we were at this moment. We spent some time just interacting as friends: I

wanted to know everybody's favorite kind of ice cream, sherbet, or frozen yogurt. My long-ago friend Jim McCall always answered: "I prefer pie." As for me: I like both pie and ice-cream. I like sherbet and frozen yogurt as well!

In table groups, we discussed two questions: 1) what are the things you value about his church in its ministry right now? and then 2) What would you like to see happening here in the next five years?
