Dear Friends,

We are PREPARING TO SAIL! That means we are working to imagine what God's vision might be for First Presbyterian St. Petersburg, moving forward, and how we understand and claim God's vision for us as our mission in this community and world.

We started *Preparing to Sail* this past Sunday as I spoke with you about our ship, the church, and what we believe about God. God is always our starting point. After all, the Lord's Prayer begins: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy Name.

This week we consider our place in the world as we look at the prayer's next words: Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done, on earth as in heaven. Good words, after our wonderful, powerful visit with musicians of Ukraine, now dear friends.

God's Loving Gift of Community

It may have been historic: 900-1000 people gathered in our Sanctuary for 2 hours, mesmerized by the music of 28 young Ukrainian women and their exuberant conductor. The concert was an expression of their love for their Ukrainian community amid the terrible war with Russia. It was exhilarating and touched the hearts and souls of our faith community, the St. Petersburg community and beyond.

They gave us abundant gifts through music, through smiles, and through the stories they shared.

We gave them the gift of hospitality in so many ways: hosts who have been moved



by the presence and conversations with their Ukrainian guests; food - and plenty of it for lunches, a sitdown, china-plated American style Sunday dinner as well as a good-ole' American bar-bque dinner - and a new-found favorite for them - mangoes!

Our loving gifts to them were the beginnings of relationships and a financial gift for their humanitarian aid to widows, orphans, and war victims. They will soon be trained to tend not only to the physical and spiritual needs of their country, but also to the PTSD needs of so many people. As of now, over \$48,000 will be given to their mission. Amazing how our loving God has moved us to reach across

the globe to help in this time of need!

Communications throughout the local community brought many inquiries, requests, and donations that were above and beyond our expectations. We at First Presbyterian Church have been and will continue to be blessed because of this.
