
# **WORSHIP THIS SUNDAY**



To help you think about people you might like to suggest, here are brief explanations for the offices of elder and deacon:

- <u>ELDERS</u> are the spiritual officers of the church who work together and with the pastors to guide the congregation in worship, mission, stewardship and the church's overall vision for ministry.
- <u>DEACONS</u> are the officers who provide care for the sick, for homebound, for those in special need. They make calls, visit, take flowers or meals to show the love of Christ and the congregation.

BOTH ELDERS AND DEACONS undergo training, examination by the Church Session, and are ordained (set apart) at worship for their office.



## Create To Share Meal Ministry

The Create To Share Meal program allows our church to provide one meal to a First Presbyterian person in distress or stress due to: death in the family, major surgery/ prolonged illness or hospitalizations, traumatic relocation due to fire, flooding, etc., or birth in the family. Each meal consists of an entrée or casserole, vegetables, rolls and dessert.




