# A wonderful weekend with our consultant, the Rev. Cameron Trimble

FPC began its revitalization journey in earnest last weekend with the visit of the Rev. Cameron Trimble, CEO of Convergence, a church consulting firm based in Atlanta that has helped dozens of congregations across the globe assess their health and discern what God

is calling them to do next in our changing world.

To get to know us: On Friday Rev. Trimble toured St. Petersburg (paradise, she says!) and talked with members of the staff. Saturday was spent meeting 37 members in groups of twos and threes to learn what keeps people at FPC, and hear their concerns, hopes, and dreams for the future of the church. On Sunday she attended all three services and made two presentations to the congregation based on her observations and research of mainline churches and the results of the more than 200 surveys (a great response, she said) that our congregation completed. (There is still time to complete a survey at <a href="this link">this link</a>, or you may pick a printed copy up in the worship spaces or church office and return it to the office.)

Who did she talk with? All members had the opportunity to take the survey provided in advance by Convergence, and to attend the question and answer sessions after worship on Sunday. To offer Rev. Trimble a diverse and balanced variety of members to speak with in the limited number of time slots available, members of the Revitalization Team prayerfully considered these categories:

- Length of membership: new and long-time
- Age: wise and younger
- Representation of church groups: choir, Presbyterian Women, Stephen Ministries, Deacons, Men's Ministry, etc.
- Leadership: Cameron asked to meet with all session members

**Next steps:** Rev. Trimble praised FPC at the meetings Sunday as "an extraordinary" church. She will write a detailed report for the session based on her first weekend. That report will be shared with the congregation (stay tuned). She will conduct weekly "coaching" calls with Pastor Dawn and/or the Revitalization Team for at least the next 12 months. She will also return at a later date for leadership training with the Session.

- 2. Purchase extra wheelchairs [number TBD] for fast egress of people with walkers during emergency [fire or other]
- 3. Hire 1-2 uniformed police with cruiser for Sunday 7:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
- 4. Lock several doors [TBD] 5 minutes after each service starts, have sign on door to direct people to unlocked doors.
- 5. Put numbers on all [TBD] doors

- 6. Install additional cameras [number TBD] throughout campus and monitoring computer station, place "We have cameras" signs on walls
- 7. Conduct emergency training for appropriate groups [TBD]
