Update On Our Search For An Associate Pastor

Our congregation's Associate Pastor Nominating (Search) Committee has been meeting regularly since the position was posted in January. We have been reviewing potential candidates who are in the church-wide database of church professionals open to a new position. We are also reviewing candidates who apply directly to First Presbyterian-St. Petersburg or who are referred by our members or others. To date we have had one interview on March 10th. Several others will be arranged soon, using video conferencing technology. As with other aspects of our church's life, our search is affected by safety concerns and has to address them.

You can help by continuing to send recommendations our way. These are some of the most promising leads. You can also help by praying that the Holy Spirit guides our search, bringing the right person to our church's call and giving the Committee and candidate the discernment to know when that call is right.
