The Mission Committee will match each card with an additional \$25 gift card. We will include a note..."From your friends at First Presbyterian Church".




The Associate Pastor Nominating Committee Is Making Good Progress

The Associate Pastor Search Nominating (Search)
Committee started work on September 4, meeting with
Pastor Dawn and Presbytery officials for a briefing on the
process and to get organized. Since then, the Committee has
met almost every week (eight times) and calls and emails

have also been flying back and forth.

The committee's first task has been crafting a Ministry Information Form in consultation with Pastor Dawn and the Session's job description. This Ministry Information Form profiles our congregation's composition and programs, describes how a new Associate Pastor would fit into our efforts, and identifies desired skills and the duties the Associate Pastor is expected to perform. The Presbyterian Church requires that congregations think carefully about church priorities and needs before conducting a candidate search.

The Ministry Information Form was approved by our Session on October 28 and now goes to the Presbytery's Commission on Ministry for its review on November 6. After both Session and Presbytery approve the form, the Associate Pastor position can be posted for applicants to consider. The next phase will be identifying and screening applications for further consideration.
