Attend In-Person Worship In The Sanctuary

If you attend in person, please remember:

You will need to reserve a spot to attend. There are two ways to register:

- (1) Go online! An email will be sent to you each Monday morning with a link to click to RSVP for the upcoming Sunday. You will also find a RSVP button on the main page of our website, or you can go directly to <a href="mailto:fpcstpete.com/rsvpforsunday">fpcstpete.com/rsvpforsunday</a>. Please complete ALL boxes, then click "Submit to RSVP" **OR**
- (2) Call the Church Office (727-822-2031) Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and noon (please note that the office is closed today for the Thanksgiving holiday). You will be asked a series of questions; some will be health-related. All information collected will be kept confidential. No reservations will be accepted after Friday at noon, and voicemail messages are not RSVPs. If you aren't able to RSVP, we are accepting walk-ins on Sunday morning as space is available.
  - Remember: You will be required to wear a mask. If you forget one, we will have extras available.
  - Hand sanitizer will be available in several easy-to-access spots for your safety.
  - Please note that the elevator will NOT be accessible.
  - The sanctuary will have **one entrance** and **one exit** <u>only</u>. Signs will point you in the right direction.
  - For your safety, prior to service, you will check in at the front doors, and be seated by ushers at a safe social distance.
  - We ask that you do not congregate in the sanctuary at all after the service. If you wish to stop and visit with friends, make your way out of the sanctuary first and visit outside. We want you to spend as little time inside the sanctuary as possible.

Thank you in advance for your patience with these new procedures. We look forward to meeting for in-person worship while maintaining the safest environment possible!

The call of Rev. Megan McMillan as our new Associate Pastor was overwhelmingly approved at the Congregational Meeting last Sunday. She brings a lot to


